TO PUT IT SIMPLY, THERE CAN BE NO MEANINGFUL REDUCTION IN THE RATES OF SEXUAL VIOLENCE WITHOUT CHANGING THE BEHAVIOR OF MEN.

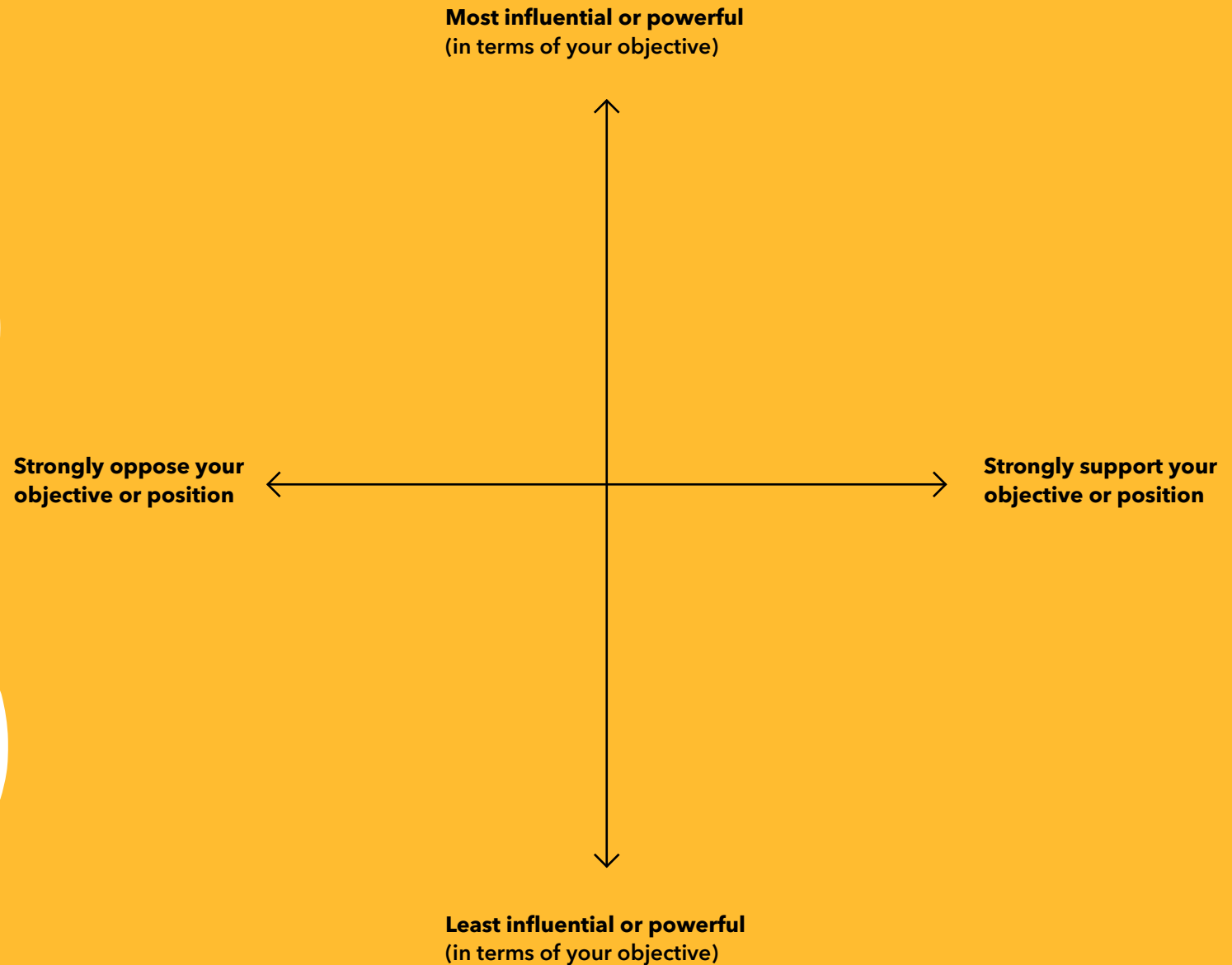
